6	SEARCH.—In this section, the term "gain-of-function re-
7	search" means any research that—
8	(1) could confer attributes to influenza, MERS,

11	nism; or
12	(2) involves methods that could enhance poten-
13	tial pandemic pathogens or related risky research

15	(b) Prohibition.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
16	sion of law, no research grants supported by Federal funds
17	may be awarded to institutions of higher education, or
18	other research institutes, that are conducting gain-of-func-
