To amend the Food Security Act of 1985 to reauthorize the voluntary public access and habitat incentive program.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Voluntary Public Ac-5 cess Improvement Act of 2025".

6 SEC. 2. VOLUNTARY PUBLIC ACCESS AND HABITAT INCEN7 TIVE PROGRAM.

8 Section 1240R of the Food Security Act of 1985 (16

9 U.S.C. 3839bb-5) is amended by striking subsection (f)

10 and inserting the following:

1 "(f) FUNDING.—

2 "(1) MANDATORY FUNDING.—Of the funds of
3 the Commodity Credit Corporation, the Secretary
4 shall use to carry out this section \$150,000,000 for
5 the period of fiscal years 2025 through 2029.

6 "(2) Enhanced public access to wetland 7 RESERVE EASEMENTS.—To the maximum extent 8 practicable, of the funds made available under para-9 graph (1), the Secretary shall use \$3,000,000 for 10 the period of fiscal years 2025 through 2029 to en-11 courage public access to land covered by wetland re-12 serve easements under section 1265C through agree-13 ments with States and tribal governments under this 14 section.".
